This letter is to follow up the 24 hour phone verification with you office that occurred today concerning stormwater grab sample results for 9-5-06. Per the notification requirements of Part II, Section A.2.(b) of the referenced permit, we report the following:

Allen's - Harbeson Stormwater 002 Grab Sample

BOD5	32.2 mg/L
Total Suspended Solids	490 mg/L
Oil & Grease	15.2 mg/L
Fecal Enterococcus	140,000 / 100 mls

Allen's - Harbeson Stormwater 003 Grab Sample

BOD5	127 mg/L
Total Suspended Solids	2720 mg/L
Oil & Grease	51.0 mg/L
Fecal Enterococcus	620,000 / 100 mls

The high concentration in the grab samples are a result of solids being flushed from the yard area. We continue to investigate this situation and will keep you informed of our findings. Changes to the pumping cycle of both stormwater pumps have been made. We
