RE: Nutrient Offset Plan Report

Dear Mr. Hansen:

This letter serves as the ninth installment of the Pinnacle Foods Corporation's Nutrient Offset Plan Report. As required by Special Condition #7 of Pinnacle's NPDES Permit DE 0000736, "The permittee shall submit progress reports every six months outlining actions taken toward implementing this plan".

The fertilizer and lime applications were completed in March and April. As agreed, 30-lbs/acre nitrogen (ammonium sulfate) and 120-lbs/acre potash (muriate of potash) were applied. 40,500 pounds of lime was spread

During the month of May the field was cut and baled. A total of 30.4 tons were hauled outside of the watershed on June 14th. The total pounds of nitrogen removed was 1522 and the pounds of phosphorus removed was 505.

Spray irrigation operations began on June 14, 2005. This system will operate from now until October. Should you have any questions please call me at 302-934-3833.
