### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

DNREC-Office of the Secretary and Division of Water, Wetlands and Subaqueous Lands Section

Pursuant to the requirements of the Subaqueous Lands Act (7 Del C., Chapter 72) and the Regulations Governing the Use of Subaqueous Lands, and the Marina Regulations, the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control will conduct a public hearing on Monday October 30, 2017, commencing at 6:00 PM at the DNREC Lewes Field Office, located at 901 Pilottown Road, Lewes, DE.

The purpose of the hearing is to solicit the views of interested parties in specific regards to the application filed by Hometown Angola Beach, LLC, to construct a major alteration to Angola Beach & Estates Marina by installing an additional 52 slips, consisting of two (2) 5 by 77 foot long floating dock extensions, two (2) 5 by 140 foot long floating piers, twenty-four (24) 4 by 16 foot long floating finger piers and approximately 84 stand-alone pilings; to realign the marina by shortening the existing fixed pier by 8 feet in length and by replacing the previously authorized floating piers with three (3) 5 by 140 foot long floating piers; and to temporarily remove the existing marina structures in order to hydraulically dredge 8,500± cubic yards to a depth of -4 feet MLW from an 108,000± square foot area in Burton Prong at the terminus of Boat Ramp Lane and to dispose of the dredged material via a pipeline to an upland confined disposal area west of Bridgeway Drive West Lewes, Sussex County, DE
