



On behalf of Allen Harim Foods, LLC, BP Environmental, Inc. respectfully submits an addendum to the State Discharge Permit WPCC 3131E/76 Renewal Application, originally submitted on October 28, 2010 by Allen Family Foods, Inc. (former property owner and occupant). This permit was transferred to Allen Harim Foods, LLC on August 24, 2011. As indicated in discussions between Allen Harim Foods, Inc. and Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Concern (DNREC), it was agreed that an addendum should be sent as a means to communicate the need for additional future discharge in 2015. Also enclosed, per DNREC's request, is a revised schematic of Harbeson's water flow.




ADDENDUM TO STATE DISCHARGE PERMIT WPCC 3131E/76
AL-130-18

Allen Harim Foods, LLC (Allen Harim) proposes the following operational and monitoring changes/ clarifications to the renewal of State Discharge Permit WPCC 3131E/76 for the Allen Harim facility located at 18752 Harbeson Road, Harbeson, DE:

- Daily average wastewater flow of 2.0 million gallons per day (MGD).

This represents a moderate increase from Allen Harim's current daily average flow limit of 1.25 MGD as given in Condition B.1 of State Discharge Permit WPCC 3131E/76. The requested increase in flow will allow Allen Harim to have the flexibility to expand poultry production, if needed, in an effort to remain competitive in the poultry industry.
